



Trespass Scheme

Trespass scheme is a voluntary addition to Farmwatch where members agree to their premises being included on a list given to known criminals who target rural communities. Criminals given the list are informed that they face legal action should they trespass on land of participants to this scheme.

Latest statistics show that members of Farmwatch are less likely than non-members in the farming community to be a victim of crime, with members of the Trespass scheme safest of all.

Cumbria Community Messaging

Communication is critical. Crime prevention is an ongoing process, not a one off event.

By joining this messaging service, you enable the police and key stakeholders e.g. Cumbria County Council, Cumbria Fire and Rescue Service, Cumbria Constabulary, and the Cumbria Neighbourhood Watch Association to send you information which can help protect you, your family and your property from harm and criminal acts.




You can elect to receive messages by email, text, or phone (voice mail). The preferred option is email.

Cumbria is an area with low levels of crime, however we would like to encourage you to increase your security and remain vigilant to deter thieves.

What is Farmwatch?

Farmers and other people living in rural communities can join the Constabulary's successful Farmwatch scheme, which is a network designed to share crime prevention advice, alert local residents to crimes in their area, and appeal for information to catch criminals.

Statistics show that members of farmwatch are less likely to be victims of crime compared to non-members in the farming community.

By joining the Farmwatch scheme you agree to receive information by phone, text or email. You will also receive free crime prevention advice on protecting your property and reduced cost (or sometimes free) security products. By keeping you informed about crime in your area, we help prevent crime, keep your community safe and sometimes catch criminals.

Smartwater


SmartWater is a property marking crime prevention and detection tool. Marking farming equipment is a deterrent to thieves as they do not want to get caught with identifiable property. SmartWater is a clear liquid, invisible to the thief, and impossible to remove completely from equipment if used correctly.

A SmartWater farm kit, and two signs are available at the discounted rate of £45 (normal price is £72 + annual fee). Signs should be displayed on your farm to advise SmartWater is in use.
